Fundraising top tips



Make a plan and spread the word

Decide where you're going to host your fundraiser, whether in your home, or in a venue in your area. You can spread the word by posting invites to your friends and neighbours, putting up posters in your local area or posting on local Facebook groups.



Maximise your fundraising

Personalise your fundraising page with details of your event and information about why you're raising money. Download your QR from your Fundraising Dashboard and display it so people can also donate online. Log into your fundraising page [here](#). Include some additional activities and competitions, like a raffle or quiz, and encourage people to donate to participate.



Keep it safe and legal

It's important that you're safe and legal whilst fundraising in aid of Pancreatic Cancer UK, especially if you're serving food and drink or organising a raffle. Please read our guidance on Fundraising and the Law [here](#).
